



Christmas Card Competition

This year we want to produce a Christmas Card on behalf of Bolton Moorland District. This will then be available for groups/sections to sell to raise funds for their group. The money raised can be used however the group sees fit, but is the ideal opportunity to raise funds for specific equipment or a special event or an international trip.

All young people from Squirrels to Explorers are invited to take part. The winning design will be printed as this year's Christmas Card, and the winner invited to watch them being produced.

What you need to know

- The design should be on the theme of 'Scouting at Christmas'.
- It should be drawn or painted on a piece of A4 paper or produced electronically. It can be portrait or landscape. The winning design will be scanned, so it must be flat, so please avoid added extras like glitter, or googly eyes, or fairy lights.
- The card will be printed in full colour. We will add the Scouts logo if it isn't incorporated as part of the design.
- Make sure you include your name, section, group and some contact details (email or phone).
- Entries to be collated by each group and submitted by Tuesday 2nd November by email or hardcopy to the District Commissioner.
- The judging panel will make their selection by the end of that week and the winner notified.

We aim to have the finished cards printed and available by the end of November.

As we are on a very tight timescale, there is no movement in the closing date.

The winning design will be produced on A6 cards. Groups will be able to purchase the cards at cost from the District (£1.00 per pack of 10, including envelopes) and can then resell to raise funds for their group. We recommend a selling price of £4.00 per pack.

In order to ensure we produce sufficient cards in the 1st run, we will ask groups to indicate an approximate order volume. We will send you the proof as soon as it is agreed, so you can show to your parents/supporters/fellow leaders.
